
School Council

Introduced suggestion box to KS2 to give pupils a voice about things that they believe are important about our school and possible improvements. School council have sorted through all suggestions and ranked them according to cost, fun and importance. From this we selected our projects.





Project 1 – Tuck shop

Firstly we had to ring the tuck shop lady and sort out a meeting with her. The Friday after, we had a meeting with her at Paston Ridings Primary School. She gave us some of the healthy tuck shop food to try. We had to sort out our roles in the tuck shop. We are having a launch assembly on Friday 13th May and then our 22 children who are tuck shop team have a days training with the lady from 'Fruit to suit'.



<u>Project 2 – Playtimes and lunchtimes</u>

Created a questionnaire to identify strengths and weaknesses about playtimes for children and adults.

Meet with key adults about playtimes and lunchtimes.

Class discussions about possible improvements.

Researched ideas and looked at prices/costings.

Created an application form for children to become play pals for lunchtime and playtimes.

<u>Project 3 – Community voice and publicity</u>

Re-designed the suggestion form and got a new suggestion box.

Introduced a new house point system (but not everything has arrived yet).

Creating an evaluation form for enrichment activities for children, staff and parents.

Creating a short film about our school that can be used to encourage new staff and new children to join the Paston team.
