PUPILS

As a pupil at Paston Ridings I will:

- Show respect and consideration for all adults and children who work and play in our school community.

- Take pride in my appearance and wear school dress.
- Help ensure the school is a pleasant environment in which to work and play by keeping it clean, tidy and free from litter.

PARENTS/CARERS

As a parent/carer of a pupil at Paston Ridings School I/We will:

- Ensure that my child attends school regularly and arrives at school on time.
- Support my child's learning including ensuring the completion of any homework set.
- Encourage my child to read and listen to him/her read on a regular basis.
- See that my child has what they need to take full part in all school activities.
- Support school policies and rules, and the code of conduct on behaviour.
- Attend parent's evenings and discussions about his/her progress.
- Ensure that my child complies with the school's dress code.
- Notify school as soon as possible if my child is not attending for any reason.

- Inform the school if I give my child permission to walk home on their own. **(Years 4, 5 or 6 only)**
