Remote Learning – Year 1

As part of our remote learning plan during the COVID-19 pandemic, we endeavour to support your child’s education whilst they are home learning.

We would like to offer the opportunity for some remote learning through online lessons linked to the curriculum map we use in school.

The class teacher can be contacted by your child through tapestry, by messaging them or by writing on the blog, and will be available to answer questions you may have and to support your child’s learning.

Below is a timetable which you can use to support your child during their period of time at home, we understand that this may be difficult to achieve but wanted to provide you with a guide:

They can share their learning through Tapestry.
